Be sure to include the various teaching methods you will use. Examples of methods include but are not limited to brainstorm, small group work, and role plays.
5. One or two learning objectives that describe what the participants should be able to do after attending workshop.
6. An outline/agenda that details the procedural steps of your workshop.
